Re: Iceland Trip 26th October – 30th October

As our day of departure approaches, I thought I would write to you with travel details and information regarding the trip.

Travel Details

We will be departing from NSB at **08:00 prompt**, travelling to London Heathrow on Wednesday 26th October. The flight is with Icelandair at 13:10 – Flight No. F1451.

The return flight – Flight No. F145X will be on Sunday 30th October, arriving at London Heathrow at 19:30 and we expect to arrive back at NSB at approximately 22:45.

Students will be asked to contact home on the return journey to update you on the estimated arrival time.

Important things to remember

- All those travelling must have their passports with them in their hand luggage together with their EHIC.
- Luggage allowance is up to 23Kg (hold luggage). On board hand luggage should be of standard size for flights (please check Icelandair website if in doubt of correct size).
- Travellers will need both British and Icelandic currency. Recommended amounts were discussed at parents' evening. I would advise that Icelandic currency is obtained as soon as possible.
- A refillable water bottle might be useful.
- Itinerary details were distributed to parents at the recent parents' evening.
- Emergency School contact is : - 01604 230240 (daytime) or Mr O Harris - 01480 861035 (out of school hours) – **I must stress that this number is for emergency only and not for travel information.**

Please Note - Any electronic devices taken in hand luggage must be fully charged. If they cannot be switched on at security checkpoint, they can be confiscated.

Swimming

It is intended that as part of the itinerary we will visit the Secret Lagoon – a thermally heated swimming facility and possibly other swimming pools. Please return the reply slip below as a matter of urgency indicating if you give permission for your son/daughter to take part in the water based activities. Failure to do so will mean that they will be unable to participate.

I hope that the information in this letter and that given at the parents' evening has answered any queries you may have. Can I remind you that a suggested kit list was included in the information pack you received.
