How to collect results?

The school will be open from 09:00am for students to come in and collect their results. Please enter via the Red Doors at the front of the school. An envelope containing your results can be collected in the Concourse.

A breakdown of results will also be available on AIM from approximately 09:00am.

Access to Scripts Form

In the envelope is a yellow Access to Scripts Form. It is important that you sign this, and hand it in at the 1911 Hall before you leave on Results Day. This will allow staff to recall your scripts and identify if there are any issues from reading through them.

UCAS Admissions / Clearing

UCAS Track updates at 8am. We will be running support sessions in the Upstairs Sixth Form Centre with a team of staff for students on Results Day. The times will be outlined in Mrs Bradley-Brophy's email. Parents will be able to attend these support clinics.

Please only come into the Upstairs Sixth Form Centre if you require Post-18 support. There will be no opportunity at these sessions to discuss grades or reviews of marking.

Do you think that your grade is incorrect?

We hope that you are happy with your grade. However, if you are unhappy with your grade or if your raw mark is very close to the next grade boundary then you may wish to apply for one or more exam scripts (papers) to be reviewed by the Exam Board. In the first instance, we would recommend discussing this with subject teachers and Curriculum Team Leaders. Where this has impacted university offers, it is crucial that you speak with Mrs Bradley-Brophy regarding advice and support.

All requests must be made through the school and not directly to the Exam Board. The Exam Boards will not accept approaches for a Review of Marking by candidates or their family. There is a fee per paper/unit requested which is payable by the candidate, however if the review is recommended by the school, then associated fees will be paid for by the school.

A Review of Marking requires a separate green sheet to be completed, which identifies that results could move up, down, or stay the same. These need to be submitted to the Exams Office.

What to do if you are away on Results Day?

Results can be collected by a family member, if you are unable to come in to school on Results Day. For these to be collected, please email exams@nsb.northants.sch.uk (from your school email account) with the name of the person collecting the results at least 48 hours before Results Day.

The person collecting the results will have to present a valid form of identification. Please note, only the person named can collect results on your behalf.
